- 8. Bids must be submitted to the Employer's office on or before 12:00 hours on May 2, 2017. Documents received after this deadline will not be accepted. Bids shall be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 14:00 hours local time on May 2, 2017 at the Employer's office. Bids must be valid for a period of 180 days counting from the day of Bid opening and must be accompanied by Bid security, amounting to a NRs. 150,000,000.00 (in words: Nepalese Rupees one hundred fifty million only) which shall be valid for minimum 60 days beyond the Bid validity period.
