Notice for Invitation of Bids Single Stage Two Envelope System International Competitive Bidding

Following the devastating earthquake in Nepal in April 2015 the German Government committed EUR 25 million for financial cooperation and EUR 5 million for technical cooperation to support the reconstruction of the country in earthquake-affected areas. From this commitment, EUR 10 million are allocated to the health sector (BMZ No.: 2150 10 244) with its main focus on "The new construction and rehabilitation of four (4) Primary Hospitals located in Gorkha, Rasuwa, Ramechhap and Dolakha (Jiri)"in the amount of EUR 7.29 million.

The Ministry of Health and Population (MoHP) now invites eligible, qualified and experienced Contractors to the bidding processfor the above mentionedConstruction and Civil Works.

1. Brief Description of Required Works

The Project will be implemented under the overall management of the MoHP. A Project Executing Agency (PEA) is established at the Health Coordination Division, MoHPconsisting of the Chief, Health Coordination Divisionand the Consultant HYDROPLAN Ingenieur-GesellschaftmbH for the implementation of the project.

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The intended Construction Works consist offour Lots. Approximate volume of works:

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Bidders may bid for one or several Lots/contracts, as further defined in the bidding document. The procedure for the award of contracts is as follows:

The first level of evaluation assesses the contactor's qualification and technical bid (submitted in a separate envelope). Only the bids which have passed this level will be evaluated for financial bid (separate envelope) and ranked with the lowest price bid as first rank followed by the second lowest and so on. The ranking will be listed separate for each Lot.

Contracts will be awarded to the **lowest bid in each Lot**. However, multiple contracts per bidder are not allowed. A bidder will be awarded the **contract for one Lot only**even if he/she has submitted the lowest bid in different Lots.

The award of contract will start with the lot that has received the lowest number of bids on the list. The bidder who has been awarded the contract for this Lot will be disqualified from the remaining lists/Lots. Then the procedure is repeated for the Lot with the second lowest number of bids until finishing in the end with the lot that has received the highest number of bids.

Bidding will be conducted by means of the International Competitive Bidding procedure with qualification as specified in the KfW Guidelines for Guidelines for Procurement of Goods, Works and associated Services in Financial Cooperation with Partner Countries ("KfW Guidelines").

The rate(s) and price(s) quoted by the Bidder are not subject to adjustment during the performance of the Contract.

The award decision depends on the results of the tender. The employer reserves the right to reduce the volume of work by up to 50% in each lot or/and cancel entire lots.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security.

The bidders are allowed to form a **Joint Venture (JV) with a maximum of 2 partners** (including the lead firm) only.

3. Deadline for Submission of Bidding Documents and Public Opening

Contractor's Bidding Documents should be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes (one containing the qualification documents and the other the financial bid) within an outer envelope that is clearly marked "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE BID OPENING DATE - Bidding Documents, FC Recovery Programme - Component Health, BMZ 2150 10 2442"

Bidding Documents must be dully filled up and signed by the authorised person of the Bidding Company with their official seal affixed. All submitted documents and attachments must be in (or translated to) the English language.

Bidding Documents must be delivered on or before 10:00 o'clock Nepalese time on 08.02.2019. to: KfW Office Kathmandu, German Development Cooperation Office, Sanepa, Kathmandu, Nepal, GPS coordinates: 27° 40′ 46′′ North 85° 18′12′′ East (near Nick Simons Institute).



If the deadline for submission falls on a government holiday then the next working day at 10:00 o'clock shall be considered the extended deadline for submission.

Late submission of Bidding Document will be rejected.

4. Bid Opening

In the first public session, at 10:15 o'clock local time on 08.02.2019 only the Qualification Documents will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives at the KfW Office Kathmandu, German Development Cooperation Office, Sanepa, Kathmandu, Nepal, GPS coordinates: 27° 40′ 46′′ North 85° 18′12′′ East (near Nick Simons Institute).

In the second public session at 10:00 o'clock local time on 18.02.2019 only the Financial Bids of those Bidders who have fulfilled the qualification criteria will be openedat the KfW Office Kathmandu, German Development Cooperation Office, Sanepa, Kathmandu, Nepal, GPS coordinates: 27° 40′ 46′′ North 85° 18′12′′ East (near Nick Simons Institute).

5. Payments

Payments to the contractors will be made on the basis of certifications issued by the consultant and paid directly from KfW'saccount in Germany to the contractor's account.
